Everyone has been busy preparing for our Coronation party and finding out information about King Charles III, to mark this momentous occasion. I am sure you will be very impressed when you join us for our Coronation Tea Party this afternoon.

This morning we kicked off our celebrations with a performance from a drumming band, which was enjoyed by children and staff. Thank you to Tara for organising this.

Dormouse class have had lots of coronation fun. Exploring brass instruments and different properties such as cold metal and valves. Listening and moving our bodies to military band music. Using purposeful choice making to create decisions. We have also been busy with lots of arts and crafts in preparation for the tea party which we look forward to sharing with you.



This week in Squirrel class we have been learning all about King Charles III and the Coronation. We've had fun exploring the colours of the Union Jack flag and been exploring different ways of painting. We poured the three colours of paint into an egg box and worked on our motor skills by pouring it all over the paper. Some of the children also explored the paint with paintbrushes and their hands which was lots of fun.

We have also made our own crowns for the Coronation party, the children carefully selected the jewels that they wanted to add to their crowns and chose where to place them on the crown. We have been making bunting to represent ourselves which will be displayed for our coronation party and have also been practising our Makaton for the National Anthem.



In badger class we have been exploring kings and queens past and present. We have made a fact sheet about King Charles 111 and a time line of some of the important kings and queens in history. We have been making lots of crafts that we will be using to celebrate the coronation on Friday. As the weather has been nice we have spent as much time as possible out in the garden, planting and caring for our plants, ready for our garden centre at the end of term. Friday was a day of fun making goodies to share with our parents who came in to help us make flags, sandwiches and decorate biscuits.



Hedgehog class have learnt all about the Union Jack this week and have been busy creating their very own scrolls in preparation for the tea party. They have the very important job of announcing the start of proceedings and have been very busy practising around the school, using their loud and clear voices. Today they have prepared a special fruit platter to share with their parents.



Rabbit class have continued to focus on environmental sounds and have been looking at numbers 1 to 5, singing number songs, requesting our favourite songs and joining in with the actions. We have been reading the story 'Peekaboo under the sea' exploring sensory trays, using communication boards to help us express what we liked and finding the different sea creatures along the way.

The children have also enjoyed making many different art pieces to help us celebrate the King's coronation tea party at Saxon Wood as well as making our own sandwiches and biscuits.
