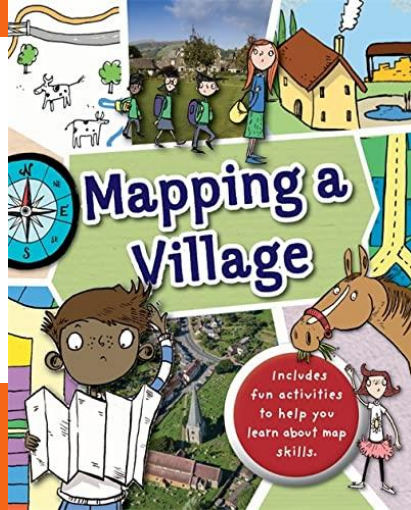

Life skills: Listening skills, communicating with peers and adults, route planning, recounting events.

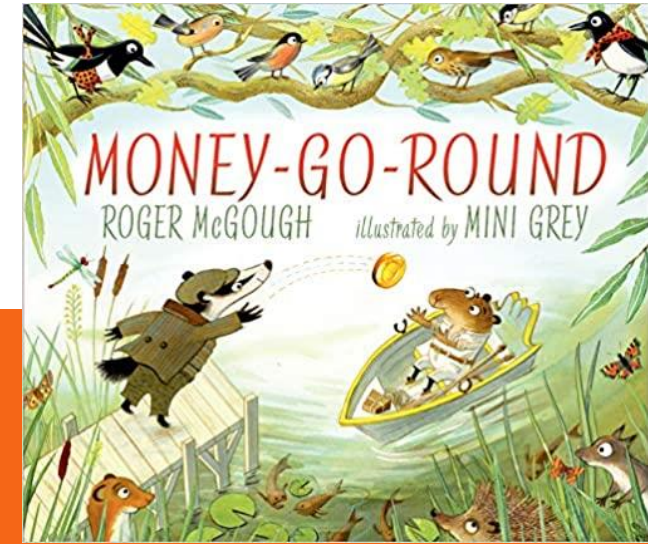
# MATHS

In sensory maths we will be Shopping with Miss Oh No! Using our shop to experience the supermarket, look at the different items and sounds we will find at the supermarket. We will also match different items to complete Miss Oh No's Shopping list.

If you have any clean boxes, cans, packets or other items we can sell in our shop please send them in.

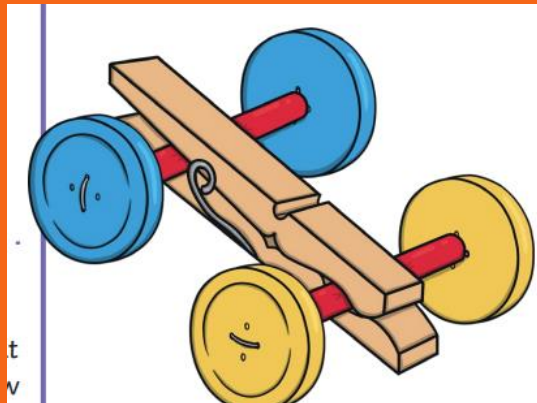


# DESIGN TECHNOLOGY AND SCIENCE

We will be linking our DT and Science sessions together as our science topic is moving toys and our challenge in DT is to research and develop a design to create appealing products that are fit for purpose.

Each child will think of a person they would like to design their moving toy for and make it appealing for that person. We will have a DT/Science day where we will make our designs. We will send out an invitation to parents to come in and join us for this session to help us make our designs. You will receive this invitation nearer the time.





# MONSTER PHONICS

We will be using our monster phonics reading scheme to send home some books for the children to read and enjoy with you. The children's books will link to the phonics they are learning or need to revise. Please read with the children at home and record into their reading journal.

The children in Rabbits, Badger and Hedgehog will be put into 5 different monster phonics groups. The children will be in mixed groups and may move to a different class for their monster phonics session to allow them to have the space and resources they need. 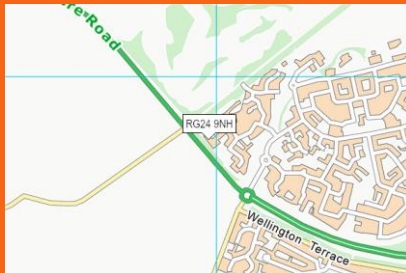
Through all our computing teaching we always have a focus on using computers and the internet safely. We will be watching this short video to spark discussions in class.

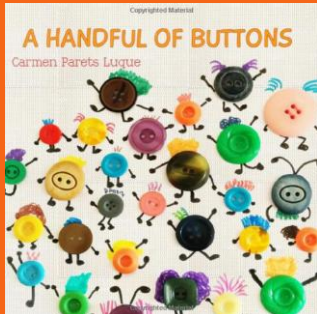
