Fox Class settled back into school quickly and were so happy to see their friends again. We have all enjoyed time in our outdoor space and especially Forest school where we had a lot of fun participating in all activities set. We also joined in our daily PE and music session where we played different instruments adjusting tempo and noise level as instructed and messy play where we could explore dry, crumbly and wet textures. The children have taken turns to visit the Sensory room where we can calm and regulate ourselves. This term our topic is summer holidays and we are planning lots of fun activities that we do when on holiday. Hopefully we are going to be blessed with lots of lovely sunny weather so we can plan a lot of them outdoors where we like to spend our time best. Badger Class enjoyed using paintbrushes made from twigs and leaves to paint an image on some fabric in their forest school session. They also enjoyed looking for and choosing some leaves to spray paint around to create a silhouette. It has been wonderful seeing children get so stuck in with forest school and to hear them express their enjoyment. In Phonics, children have been working hard at recognising various graphemes and using this knowledge to blend to read words. We have also been talking about our upcoming trip and are looking very much forward to it! Badger Class settled back into their classroom and routines very well after the break - well done Badger's for a super first week back!

Hedgehog Class have settled back in well and ready to learn. In RE our focus was remembering. The children enjoyed sharing their experiences of outings with their families and enjoyed making a card for someone special in their life's. The children have been working on the 'ure' grapheme, compound words and suffixes in phonics. In maths they are exploring number, ordering numbers and learning the language lowest, least and greatest. Due to the lovely weather the children been able to enjoy PE outside.



Squirrel Class have had a great first week back! It was really lovely to welcome back the children on Monday. We started with our new topic 'At the seaside'. Our main learning focus for the remaining of the academic year are colours, shapes, same and different. The children have already started carrying out activities in each learning area and they have been exploring basic 2D shapes in maths. In phonics we will be continuing with the same grouping where some of the children will continue with environmental and instrumental sounds while others will progress with phonics knowledge. In art this week the children have been making some personalised pieces for their special people at home. The children really enjoyed their first Relax Kids, music and Move Momentum sessions.



Dormouse Class have begun a new topic on Jungle animals and have enjoyed a sensory story of 'Rumble in the jungle'. The children explored different jungle animal figures in the tuff tray and then matched them to a picture. We have listened to lots of different jungle sounds, sung animal themed songs and nursery rhymes. We had a wonderful Forest school session this week themed around frogs where we were able to feel different textures such as crunchy leaves, slimy frogs and even some frog spawn made from chia seeds! We have also very much enjoyed our regular relax kids, music and move momentum sessions. A very busy first week back.

Could you return to school any spare clothes that your child may be sent home in as our supplies are running very low. We do ask that every child has a named bag on their peg at school with spare clothes in case they need to be changed.


