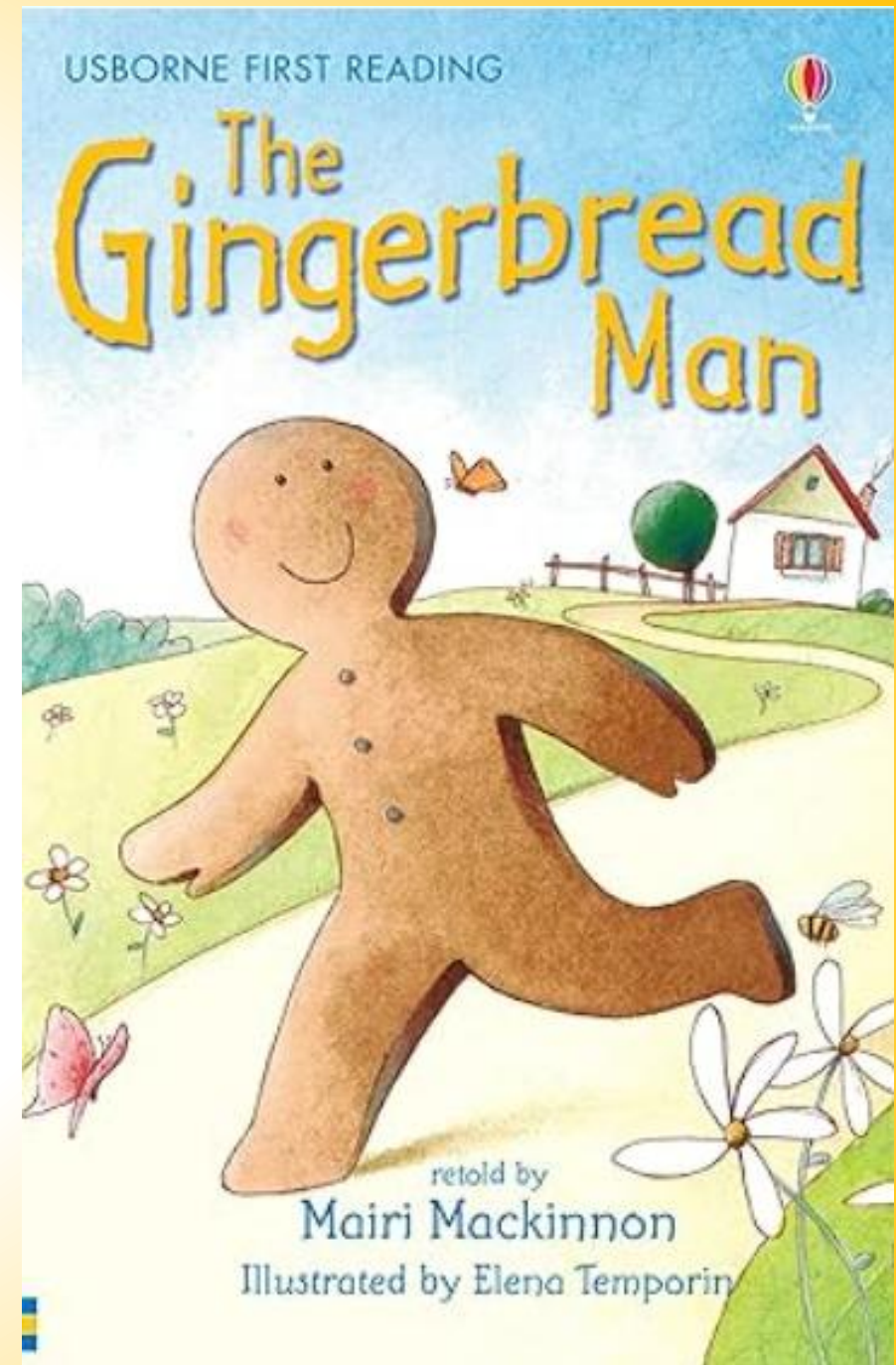

Literacy

The Gingerbread Man

We will be using *The Gingerbread Man* as a text during our Literacy lessons. We will learn to re-tell part of the story and how to describe characters. There will also be some gingerbread baking along the way!



Phonics and Reading

In phonics, children will work in small groups supported by an adult focusing on practising and learning sounds according to which phase they are working at. Children will continue practising to blend to read and segment to spell words as well as sort objects according to the sounds that they contain.

We will also visit the school library every Wednesday where children will be able to choose a book to take away with them.

All the children really do love their library session, so **please ensure that library books are returned to school on Wednesday** so they can exchange their book for a new one. Until books are returned, no new books can be issued.



Science

In science, we will be exploring rocks. We will look at different types of rock and learn how to describe them using scientific vocabulary. The children will go on a rock hunt around school and within the local area and sort them into groups.

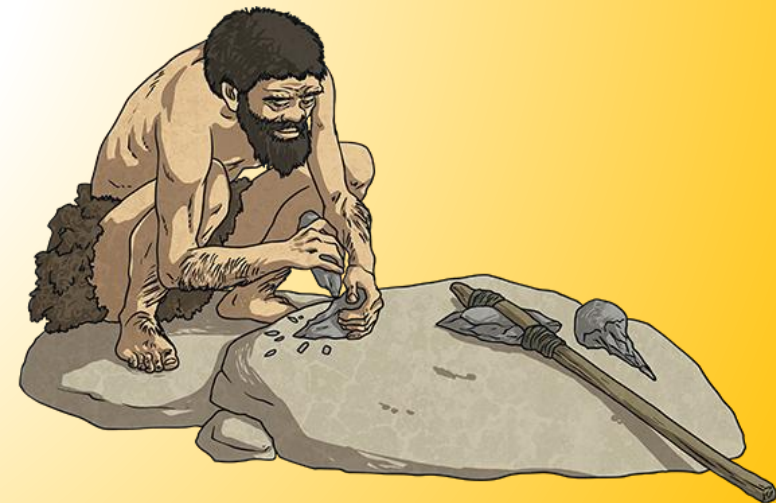
We will also be painting rocks as part of our Easter week.



History

We will spend time looking at how humans lived millions of years ago by exploring the Stone Age. Children will learn about their houses, what they ate, what they wore as well as what animals lived during these times. They will become archaeologists and dig for clues as to what life was like. We may even meet a mammoth...

This topic also links to science – rocks.



PE

In PE, we will continue circuits alongside Hedgehog class. We will also explore following simple circuit routines and how circuit training helps our physical fitness.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about Hinduism.

We will look at what Hinduism is, where they worship, as well as their celebrations and traditions.

We will also learn about The Carnival of Colour, a very important time of year for Hindus, and will participate in our own Carnival of Colour by getting very creative and a little messy, too!



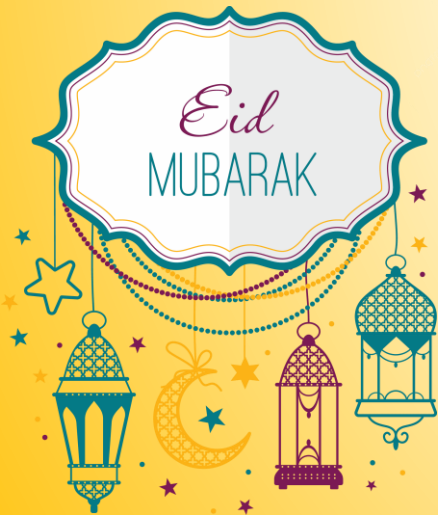
PSHE
